Legislative context

The *Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act 1988* (FFG Act) establishes a legal and administrative structure to enable and promote the conservation of Victoria's native flora and fauna.

Taxa (such as species and sub species), communities of plants and animals, and potentially threatening processes¹ (PTPs) are assessed by the Victorian Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC) and recommended to the Minister for Environment and Minister for Agriculture for inclusion in the following lists:

- Threatened List (for taxa and communities)
- Processes List (for PTPs)

Once listed, an action statement must be prepared for the taxon, community or PTP.

What is an action statement?

An action statement is a legislative tool used to inform conservation and investment decisions to support the recovery of threatened species and communities, and manage and mitigate PTPs. They are prepared with information sourced from Victorian Government datasets and decision support tools, with input from knowledge holders and the SAC.

As required by the FFG Act, an action statement must set out actions that are intended to conserve or manage a taxon, threatened community or PTP, and document actions that have been undertaken in the past. For additional context, action statements also include:

- conservation assessment status for taxa
- threats to the taxon or community
- conservation objectives
- links to information sources (e.g. decision support tools)
- resources to assist in the submission of reporting and monitoring data
- information about Indigenous Data Sovereignty and recognition that steps must be taken to avoid harm and where appropriate to ensure actions can deliver cultural benefits.

¹ Potentially threatening processes are mechanisms that have the potential to pose a significant threat to the survival or evolutionary development of Victoria's plants and animals.

Annual preparation lists

The Victorian Government is committed to preparing and publishing action statements for all listed taxa, communities and PTPs. The Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action (DEECA) prepares a list of candidates for action statement publication each financial year.

Progress to date

In 2023–24, the Victorian Government published 1,103 new action statements, (see Table 1). These included 1,095 species, 7 threatened communities and 1 PTP. Of the species, 265 were listed as Critically Endangered (CR), 665 Endangered (EN), and 165 Vulnerable (VU).

Among the threatened taxa, the focus of action statement publication was for plants, which comprise over 75% of taxa on the Threatened List.

The year ahead

Preparation and publication of an additional 707 action statements are planned for 2024–25 (see Table 2). This includes 683 species, 16 threatened communities and 8 PTPs. Of the species, 248 are CR, 350 are EN, and 85 are VU. Please note that stakeholder engagement associated with some action statements may trigger longer preparation timeframes. If required, these items will be delayed and listed again for publication in 2025-26.
