In celebration of Landcare Australia's 35th anniversary, they are launching the \$300,000 Landcare Australia Community Grants program. This initiative supports efforts to revive nature, enhance biodiversity, and empower volunteers.

Grants between \$5,000 and \$20,000 are available for Landcare groups, Bushcare, Dunecare, Coastcare, "Friends of" groups, Traditional Owners, First Nations organisations, and youth environmental groups (18+).
